It combines the modern with the traditional in terms of facilities and academic outlook and has an innovative and engaging approach to teaching and learning. In addition, the promotion of soft skills, self-confidence, concern for others, personal responsibility and leadership means that the School provides a first rate all-round education where students feel they belong and where they invariably develop academically, socially and emotionally.

Students enjoy the friendly and purposeful atmosphere at Battle Abbey and have a real affection for the School. From the very start at the Prep School, they learn to be inquisitive and creative individuals who are challenged to do their best. They learn how to interact with students from all over the world as well as with people of all ages. We also have a unique enrichment programme which sees students introduced to subjects, topics and issues that are not covered in a typical exam syllabus. Furthermore, we are very good at finding skills and aptitudes in students that they don't always know that they possess and we try very hard to develop those newly found strengths and interests. Academic success is something we value highly, but we are proud of the achievements of our pupils in all fields. Our pupils invariably achieve their best because we believe the pastoral care and the relationships that exist are exceptional.

The Academic Curriculum



Our varied and engaging curriculum at Battle Abbey Prep allows for each student to discover their strengths and make the most of their talents within the school and beyond.

Our teachers constantly adapt lessons and content to match the interests and skills of our pupils, while also driving the development of their specialist subjects with their enthusiasm and expertise, to create a love of learning for all children. The most recent development in our curriculum is the addition of Spanish (from Key Stage 2) and STEAM as a stand-alone subject. STEAM brings together the disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths and will be taught as a project-based learning opportunity in our dedicated purpose built facility on-site at the Prep School. It will allow for the children to understand how each of these subjects are intertwined and develop their skills in problem solving, creative thinking and team work. '

Our inclusive curriculum doesn't stop at the academic subjects, with our vision for Sport and Physical Education allowing for opportunities for all children at all levels of ability. We believe that experiencing sport in a safe and supportive environment allows for the children to thrive and positively contribute to their development and wellbeing. The weekly timetable combines Games lessons with Swimming sessions and offers inter-school fixtures for a competitive experience.

Battle Abbey Prep offers a rigorous system of academic tracking with standardised exams for English, Maths and Science completed yearly, in addition to teacher assessments and end of topic tests. Pupil progress is valued, with an emphasis on ensuring that all children meet and exceed their potential. Parents are kept informed through termly reports, effort grades and Parent-Teacher progress meetings. A full school report is issued at the end of the summer term.'



The Enrichment Curriculum

Enriching experiences outside the classroom are essential in ensuring that our children thrive and flourish. We offer extensive and varied extra curricular activities to suit everyone, including a wide range of sporting, academic and skill building clubs, House Competitions, Workshops and Trips and many sessions (as voted in by the school council) are simply about relaxing and having fun!

Participation in Forest School and Beach School coupled with frequent educational offsite visits allow children to transfer their learning and build their problem solving and teamwork skills. Our specialist staff (from both our Prep and Senior School) and our parent and community 'reallife' experts inspire and challenge pupils through talks, workshops and themed days. Our breathtaking historical grounds host exciting and memorable educational and social events organised for our children and their families.

Fundraising and outreach programs allow our students to develop an understanding of the real world and the importance of community. Our pupils develop a strong moral compass and a healthy appreciation for life. Regular school productions and musical concerts allow our students to develop their confidence and performing art skills. Our regular inschool challenges bring our House families together in mixed ages across the school to work together and support each other in a light-hearted and competitive manner.

A fun, but challenging, more able program affords additional opportunities for stretching our learners potential and giving children opportunities to really shine. Many students enter and experience great success in local and national competitions (both sporting and academic).







Creating a Learning Environment

Situated in Bexhill, in bright airy classrooms, the National Curriculum is broadly followed and supplemented by specialist teachers with dedicated rooms for many subjects. A gymnasium, ample playing fields, a large astro turf pitch and a 25 metre, six lane, heated swimming pool allow for a full and varied range of physical activities. Our impressive facilities enable us to introduce every child to a range of activities so that they can identify those which they most enjoy, and at which they most excel. The Nursery is set in the grounds of the Prep School occupying a bright, modern purpose built building. The Nursery is an integral part of Battle Abbey Prep School and indeed the wider school family.

The Head of Prep is responsible for the leadership and management of the Prep School and Nursery, in close collaboration with the Headteacher of Battle Abbey School.

Vision and Strategy

- Support the Headteacher, Board of Governors and Senior Leadership Team to deliver the whole school vision and strategic plan and lead on the development of the vision for the Prep School and Nursery.
- Ensure effective implementation, monitoring and development of wholeschool culture and initiatives.

Leadership and Management

- Ensure effective day to day running of the Prep and Nursery.
- Line manage the Nursery Manager, Prep Director of Enrichment, Prep Director of Academics and the Prep School Office.
- Ensure the Prep School and Nursery are fully compliant with DfE and local authority child protection and safeguarding regulations and best practice.
- Ensure the school policies and regulatory requirements for curriculum, premises, health and safety and wellbeing of staff and pupils are met (including for ISI and Ofsted).
- Lead on inspection preparation for the Prep and Nursery including EYFS.
- Work with the Headteacher and Bursar to deliver sound financial management and efficient use of resources.
- Ensure the Nursery is effective in operation and delivery of high quality childcare services promoting the wellbeing and development of children.
- A strong resilient and empathetic leader who will inspire and empower pupils and staff.
