

Additional Notes

- 1. A Non refundable registration fee is required prior to booking. Deposits will be refunded with the final invoice after the child has left. If a child is moving to the Prep School you will be asked to pay the difference between Nursery and Prep deposit which is currently £500. A further registration fee will not be required.
- 2. All Under 2 year old room bookings are made on a 50-week basis.
- 3. Pupils are required to complete 4 sessions per week in order that they can settle more easily into the Nursery (A full day counts as 2 sessions)
- 4. The Nursery operates over three terms, Autumn Term 1 Sep 31 Dec, Spring 1 Jan 31 Mar and Summer 1 Apr 31 Aug
- 5. From Sep 24 working families can apply for 15 hours per week Early Years Funding for children over 9 months, if you qualify for funding, you will be entitled to a maximum of 3 hours per day and the funding will be applied from the term after they reach qualifying age.
- 6. All children are entitled to 15 hours funding per week (3 hours per day) from the term after they turn 3 until the term in which they turn 5. Some families will be entitled to a further 15 hours per week making 30 hours funding per week (6 hours per day). Please go to www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to find out if you are eligable.
- 7. If you are entitled to funding and attend 50 weeks per year, your funding can be stretched to cover 4 days per week. If you wish to attend 5 days per week, you will be charged at the unfunded rate for the 5th day. There will also be an additional charge each term of 6 hours if 15 hours funded or 12 hours if 30 hours funded to cover the shortfall in funded hours. The charge of £6 for the Early Morning Session covers food and incidentals not covered by funding.
- 8. All additional sessions booked outside of your pre-booked termly sessions will be charged at the unfunded rate.
- 9. Sessions are booked on term in advance, with 6 weeks' notice required for a reduction in sessions. If you wish to increase your sessions you may do so depending on availability.
- 10. Fees are payable in advance, either in full on the first day of the billed term, or in equal instalments on the dates shown below. Payments can be made by Bank Transfer or debit and credit card. We also accept childcare vouchers and tax-free childcare payments.
